

REGULATIONS FOR THE SAFE OPERATION ON THE SHOOTING RANGE

Chapter 1 – Conditions for Using the Shooting Range

1. The shooting supervisor:

- 1) is responsible for the safety of shooting-range users;
- 2) assigns shooting positions to persons using the range;
- 3) keeps a register book including:
 - a) full name of the user;
 - b) firearm licence number and issuing authority, or address of a user without a licence;
 - c) signed declaration of having read the regulations.

2. Prohibited on the shooting range:

- 1) accompanying persons entering shooting positions or handling firearms;
- 2) using another user's firearm without consent;
- 3) consuming alcohol, intoxicants, or being under their influence;
- 4) using particularly dangerous ammunition as defined by law.

3. Posted visibly on the range:

- 1) the regulations;
- 2) the operating permit;
- 3) range layout including:
 - a) shooting positions;
 - b) first-aid point;
 - c) evacuation routes;
 - d) communication devices;
- 4) emergency signals list;
- 5) medical assistance contact information.

4. Liability for damage or accidents follows applicable law.

Chapter 2 – Rules for Handling Firearms

1. Firearms must be carried unloaded with open chambers; pistols/revolvers may be holstered.
2. Firearms may be unholstered only at a shooting position on the supervisor's command.
3. All handling must be done with the muzzle pointed at the bullet trap or targets.
4. Shooting begins only on command.
5. Completion of shooting must be reported to the supervisor.
6. After shooting, firearms must be unloaded, inspected, and positions left with open chambers.
7. Shooting and aiming only at designated positions and targets.

Chapter 3 – Conduct on the Shooting Range

1. Users must strictly follow supervisor commands.
2. No entering in front of the firing line without permission.
3. Users (except persons with disabilities) must follow stance rules.
4. Upon "STOP," shooters must immediately cease fire.
5. Animals may be brought only in exceptional cases and must be leashed and supervised.
6. Violators may be removed from the range.
7. Children may be present only under direct supervision of parents/guardians.
